Winter gritting

Local Conservatives have successfully fought Council plans to scrap the winter gritting of many roads in Bamford Ward.

Councillor Ian Duckworth spoke out against the plans at Rochdale Township Committee pointing out that many of the roads destined for removal from the programme were on steep inclines and have a junction with main roads!

The Council have now done a U-Turn and all the roads have been re-instated.

COUNCIL TAX SHOCK!

Despite the Government providing Councils with the money to freeze Council Tax for the second year running, Rochdale Lib Dems want to raise next year's Council Tax to the level of inflation!

Commenting, Councillor Jane Gartside said: "This demonstrates

just how out of touch Rochdale Lib Dems are. An increase of this magnitude, which would be over 5%, would mean real hardship for local people, especially the elderly and those on fixed incomes. Rochdale Conservatives will be supporting the Council Tax freeze."
